3. An **Official High School Transcript** which includes first semester grades of the Senior year (must be signed by a certified official authority)
4. **Two** Letters of Recommendation (*1 Teacher **or** Administrator; **AND** *1 Community Service **or** Work Experience) **Please note*** ONLY **one** from each category
5. **ESSAY** - One **typed page**, double-spaced, 12-point Times New Roman font

***ESSAY Question: How can volunteerism impact personal growth and community? Highlight your own volunteer experiences, the challenges you faced, and how it has shaped your character and future goals.**

6. Submit a photo of self. Applicant's name should be printed under the photo (No proofs, cell phone, personality or scanned photos)
